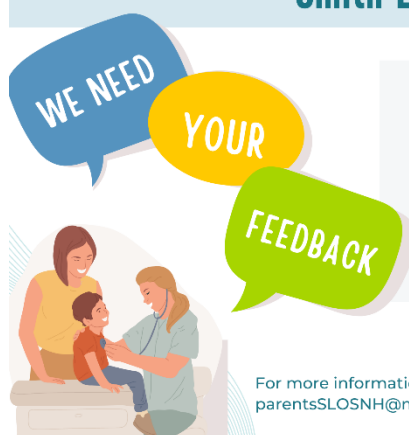


Links to the SLOS Natural History Survey in 16 languages
